An amount equal to 25% of the Annual Composite Fee is billed as a Reenrolment Fee in November 2023 and is normally payable in full by 28 November 2023. The balance of the Annual Composite Fee is payable in three equal instalments payable 28 February, 28 May and 28 August 2024.

All families are required to pay their fees via Direct Debit.

Parents may elect to pay their school fee account										
in 10 monthly instalments or 20 fortnightly instalments starting November 2023.										
Families experiencing financial difficulty may apply for an alternative payment										
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Families with 2, 3 or 4 students concurrently attending the College will receive a discount of 10%, 20% or 30% respectively off the Annual Composite Fee.

An Early Payment discount of \$250 per student applies if all annual fees and charges are paid on or before 28 February 2024.

Parents experiencing financial hardship can apply for a fee reduction. Applications are to be made in writing to the Principal. Application forms are available via email <u>sgepp@olmc.vic.edu.au</u> or from the Accounts Receivable Office.

Holders of a valid means-tested Health Care Card (includes Pensioner, Foster Parent or Veterans Affairs Concession Cards) may be eligible for CSEF funding. Card holders are asked to forward a copy to the College to enable us to apply for CSEF funding to be allocated directly towards your school fee account. Families with a valid Health Care Card will also be eligible for a \$500 per student low income discount.
